CALL TO ORDER: Claudia Sudweeks called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Brenda read minutes of last meeting held on 18 January 2024. Eric motioned to approve minutes as read. Charlie seconded the motion. Voting was unanimous.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. Public meeting protocol was presented by Stephanie Cottle, Highland City Recorder. There must be a quorum present to hold a meeting. Agenda must be posted 24 hours before meeting. Three days after meeting, approved minutes are to be sent to Stephanie Cottle.

2. Business: Change of President, introductions. Claudia introduced herself and told about her life. She has lived in Highland since 2001. Ray made a motion to accept Claudia Sudweeks as President of Highland Historical Society. Seconded by Charlie Greenland. Voting was unanimous. Claudia feels there should be a vice-chairman, but said we can wait on that.

3. Community input: Claudia reported that Winnie Jensen has agreed to join the Highland Historical Society Committee. Claudia suggested Charlie Greenland become the Historian of Highland Historical Society. Eric made a motion to recognize Charlie as Historian. Claudia seconded the motion. Voting was unanimous.

4. Preserving and Sharing our history: Claudia presented her ideas on ways to preserve and share our history including interviews and videos, a collection and digitization project, website and email contact, heirlooms and artifacts in the museum, grants and funds for non-profit organizations, and ideas for education.

5. Volunteer needs: A discussion was held about volunteer needs for the future of Highland Historical Society.

6. Highland Fling: What we want our ad to say in the Fling Magazine was discussed. Ray says he is doing something with tractors for the Fling.

7. Committee positions and assignments: Claudia asked each member of the committee to make a list of historical materials we know of which we should find and include in our collections.

ADJOURNMENT: Motion to adjourn made by Eric, seconded by Ray. Voting was unanimous. Meeting adjourned at 7:47 p.m.
