**CALL TO ORDER:** Claudia Sudweeks called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

**REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Brenda read minutes of last meeting held on 18 April 2024. Ray motioned to approve minutes as read. Charlie seconded the motion. Voting was unanimous.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

- 1. Highland Farmer's Market, Highland Fling.** Claudia reported that the Highland Historical Society has been asked to move some things to bigger room for Fling Saturday. Display from end of parade until 2 p.m. Claudia can set up on Saturday, but needs help with display. She suggested two shifts—one from 10-12 p.m. and one from 12-2 p.m., with one person on each shift. Charlie will take the 10-12 shift and Wayne and Ray will be there from 12-2 p.m. Claudia will do clean-up. Claudia will ask Carol Buhler to bring some items to display. The Mayor would like Clinton Taylor (Disney artist) to be at our display. The theme of the Highland Fling is Hometown Heroes. Wayne suggested we honor the settling families and veterans. Charlie explained the app Tourific. Highland is trial city for more in depth info about 15 sites in Highland. There are clips about the sites.
- 2. Volunteers – growing our society, teams.** Glen Buhler will help. Tami Wilcox and Michelle Smith were also mentioned. Claudia has compiled a list of those who are willing to help HHS. Stake Relief Society Presidents are willing to incorporate projects into their service days.
- 3. Educational opportunities.** Charlie mentioned school presentations which HHS could present at end of school year for 4<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades. Lone Peak High School video teacher offered to have students interview older residents of Highland. Also suggested Sterling Scholar service projects as a possibility.
- 4. Museum –fundraising.** Quentin White has a massive amount of stuff to donate. Claudia and Charlie visited him to see his stuff. Could partner with Arts Council to get City to build building for joint use. We need to begin fund raising now. We need to find big donors first. Claudia asked board to think about who we could invite to some kind of event to kick off fund raising.
- 5. Digitizing records.** Claudia said we need to catalog what is in Museum. She will create documents for each item. We need to build teams to catalog artifacts, search other records, handle fund raising, grants, etc.
- 6. Video interviews –youth.** Claudia asked board to think about who would be good to interview and help find contact info. Also think about what questions to ask. Mention in board meeting who is going to be interviewed, then anyone who has info on that person can add to the interview. The board suggested the first five to be interviewed are: Charlie, Eric Adamson, Mark Thompson, Carol Buhler and Quentin White. Dennis LeBaron was also mentioned.
