Conditions of Reimbursement Grant

The City will provide \$50.00 per linear foot of replaced fencing as a reimbursement grant for residents along Alpine Highway to replace the existing wood/masonry fence with the City-approved fence:

Material and Type: Pre-cast concrete fence, "Ashler Sandstone" design, by Olympus Precast

Color: Base: Heather Gray. No secondary colors street-side. Interior colors chosen by resident

Grant funding is limited to \$80,000 per fiscal year, subject to future appropriations. Applications are funded based on application date. The existing and replacement fences are privately owned and maintained. The City assumes no ownership or maintenance obligations by this grant. You are responsible to repair and restore all damage caused by the fence replacement, whether caused by you or a contractor, including damage to curbs, sidewalks, sprinklers, sod, landscaping, and trees. You are responsible for all costs of this project, including costs to remove the current fence, install the new fence, dispose of construction/demolition waste, and clean, repair, and restore any affected property. You are responsible to negotiate, secure, execute, and enforce any contract or approval required to facilitate the fence replacement and property restoration, including UDOT access approval. You agree to indemnify and hold the City harmless from any claim, cause of action, liability, damage, or loss arising out of any such contract or approval or arising out of the fence replacement and property restoration work. Reimbursement will be issued after inspection by City staff confirms the fence has been installed and all affected property is repaired and restored.
